## Computing

Using IT to create memories:

We will be looking at our understanding of IT, how we use it, what inputs we have and how to take and edit a photograph.

#### Art

We will continue looking at painting/colour mixing. We will be learning how to use a range of materials, looking at Artists such as Claude Monet, Georgia O'Keefe, and Rosie Sanders. We will also be looking at textiles and pattern. We will be looking at using the wax resist technique.

## **Design and Technology**

Our focus will be on Textiles and joining techniques. We will be making our own hand puppets. We will design, make and evaluate our puppets.

## **Physical Education**

This half term we will have a focus on attacking and defending skills. The children will start to learn how to use these skills across different games.

## **English-Writing**

We will be writing our very own invention narrative and explanation for their own machine.

We will continue to look at specific spelling patterns using suffixes and prefixes.

We will be looking at using the correct tense in our writing and using different types of sentences.
