## Return to School September 2023

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all having a nice summer break, I just wish we had seen better weather!

I thought I would send an update with reminders for the return to school and some additional changes that will be implemented.

Shoes	Sensible black flat school shoes or <b>plain black</b> trainers with no other colour.
Socks	White/grey/black Grey/black tights
Nursery	White polo top and grey or navy-blue joggers/leggings with Navy Blue school jumper or cardigan with Logo
PE Kit	White plain t-shirt or with school Logo Navy blue shorts or plain navy tracksuit bottoms Plain navy jumper/jacket/hooded top Sports trainers

Uniform is listed above, please ensure all children have correct school uniform, including shoes.

### **PE DAY**

PE will be taking place every Friday; children should come to school dressed in their PE kit. This must be the PE kit listed above and no colour variations or sports logos please.

### **What does my child need to bring to school?**

Your child will need to bring a named water bottle, a waterproof coat and their book bag. Their book bag will store their reading diary, reading book and any homework or letters that are to come home. As always, no big rucksacks please as we do not have the storage space for these. Please ensure book bags are in school every day. Children do not need pencil cases.





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### **Will my child need to bring a snack?**

Your child can either bring money to buy snack from the school kitchen (snack menu on the website) or they can bring their own healthy snack into school. No crisps or chocolate bars please. We also have a child with a nut allergy in school so no products containing nuts to be brought into school.

### **How do I pay for school dinners?**

If your child is in reception, year 1 or year 2 they all have universal free school meals. If your child in y3-6 is entitled to free school meals, there is nothing you need to do. If you pay for school meals, please ensure payment is made on Parent Pay before the start of the day. Dinner menu is on the school website for you to view.

### **Where will I drop off and collect my child?**

From September, we will begin to use the gated access next to the skate park. This is for the safety of all children as the top gate gets very busy, especially at the end of the day. Parents who drive, will be able to use the skate park car park. I will be on the gate each morning to welcome the children.

### **Start of day**

**Nursery** children will continue to walk down the ramp at the front of school and through the nursery door. There is no change here.

**Reception and Year 1**- Parents can walk their child through the gate next to the skate park, across the playground to the entrance for Reception and Year 1 where Miss Sands will be waiting.

**Year 2,3,4,5 & 6** - Parents will leave children at the gate and they will enter the playground and then walk up the ramp through to their door and into their cloakroom. There will be staff along the ramp to welcome children into school.

**Resource Provision**- Please enter the gate near the skate park and you can walk children up the ramp towards their classroom door. **PLEASE ADVISE TAXI DRIVERS OF THIS CHANGE.**

**The gate will close at 8.50, after this time children must enter through the school office and sign in as late.**

### **End of Day**

At the end of the school day, the gate next to the skate park will be open from 3.10. Parents can come onto the playground to wait for their child to be dismissed.

**Reception and Y1-** Will start being dismissed at 3.15. Parents can walk up through the gate on the skate park, through the playground to the reception and year one class gate

**Y2,3,4,5 & 6-** will be dismissed at 3.20. Parents, please wait on the playground.

Any child who has permission to walk home alone will be dismissed from the gate at 3.20.

No dogs are permitted on the school site or smoking or vaping please.

### **Breakfast club and after school clubs**

Children to be dropped off and collected from the main office as they do currently.

### **Any further questions about collection or drop off**

I will be on the gate the first morning back to school at the end of the day, so if you have any questions, I will be on hand to answer. Key points to remember- all children in Nursery continue to enter and collect as you do now, Reception- Y6 enter through the gate next to the skate park. We have had a new bike rack positioned inside the gate for children who cycle or scoot to school.
