I write to you today with such sad news. On Sunday 19th March at 9.30pm, one of our WPAT maintenance officers Ste Rowley lost his life in a road traffic incident. As a multi Academy Trust and as a school, we were deeply shocked to learn that we had lost a deeply valued member of the school community. Ste was woven into the fabric of the Warrington Primary Academy Trust.

You may remember Ste from the early days of Frodsham Primary Academy. He worked together with the WPAT estates manager to ensure our school was looking the best it could be. He decorated our whole building, built our sensory room, supported the build of our outdoor KS1 area and improved the grounds in EYFS.

Those of us who new Ste, knew that he had a larger-than-life personality who endeared himself to everyone he met. His personality was as vibrant as his unique look. When he entered a room, you knew about it, and it was a rare occasion when you did not part company with Ste without feeling a little bit better about life.

As a school community, we will be doing a collection to help support his wife and his 8 children at this difficult time. Staff will also be completing a book of memories to include all of the ways Ste has helped the children of Frodsham Academy. If you would like to donate, please bring any donations to the school office. Next Friday, I will collate the money and visit the family home to express our deepest condolences to the family.
